

Attention TSD Families:

The universal free meals are set to expire on June 30th, 2022. That said, we are encouraging families to complete the 2021-22 Free and Reduced Application before June 30th so your children will fall under the "30 Day Grace Period" in September 2022, if you qualify.

Every year, each household maintains their Free/Reduced lunch status from the previous year for the first 30 days of the current school year, to give them enough time to complete a new application for the current year.

-A new application will be required for the 2022-23 School Year; these applications will be available in August 2022

If you think you may qualify for Free and Reduced Price Meals, please complete an application and drop it off at the following locations:
